# INDIVIDUAL HOMEBUYER COUNSELING

Once the Home Stretch Workshop is completed, participants can receive individual homebuyer counseling. Potential homebuyers will set goals and clear up barriers to homeownership. The Program Coordinator will also determine eligibility for KOOTASCA's down payment and closing cost assistance.



## DOWNPAYMENT & CLOSING COST ASSISTANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must purchase home in Itasca or Koochiching County
- Complete a Home Stretch Workshop
   & individual counseling before signing
   a purchase agreement!
- Qualify for a mortgage with a lender
- Be a first-time homebuyer or have not owned a home in the last 3 years
- Buyer must contribute \$1,000 (own funds)
- Buyer must pay 1<sup>st</sup> years homeowners insurance policy
- Receive a professional home inspection for Housing Quality Standards & Lead Based Paint
- Family income must be below the following income levels: 6.1.2021
